Rebecca S. Eisenberg is the Robert and Barbara Luciano Professor of Law at the University of Michigan Law School. She has written and lectured extensively about biotechnology patent law and the role of intellectual property in research science and has played an active role in policy debates concerning intellectual property in biomedical research. Professor Eisenberg currently teaches courses on patent law, trademark law, and FDA law and has taught courses on torts, legal regulation of science and legal issues in biomedical research. She currently serves on the Panel on Science, Technology and Law of the National Academies of Science and recently completed a term on the Board of Directors of the Stem Cell Network in Canada
