Pauline Newman, judge, United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. Received B.A. from Vassar College, M.A. in Pure Science from Columbia University, Ph.D. in Chemistry from Yale University, and LL.B. from New York University School of Law. Before appointment as circuit judge in 1984, was Director of Patents and Licensing at FMC Corporation in Philadelphia. Worked as Science Policy Specialist at UNESCO, Paris, and as research chemist at American Cyanamid Company. Served as adviser to various governmental programs, and officer and director of several bar and scientific associations. Awarded the Wilbur Cross Medal of Yale University, the Vanderbilt Medal of New York University School of Law, the Jefferson Medal of the New Jersey Patent Law Association, and the Award for Outstanding Contributions to International Cooperation of the Pacific Industrial Property Association. Distinguished Professor of Law at George Mason University School of Law. Author of articles in the fields of innovation and science and the law.
